

To give your baby a healthy start;

It is important that the mother starts having skinto-skin contact with her baby shortly after birth.

Make sure that your newborn has a hearing test before leaving the hospital.

Contact the respective Family Health Center for another heel prick even the test has already been done at the hospital.



Navel Care

The navel and the area around it must be kept clean and dry to protect the baby from tetanus and other germs.

Do not apply anything on it unless your doctor tells you otherwise.

Do not tamper with or touch the umbilical cord.

Avoid covering the umbilical cord by keeping the diaper below the belly button.



Bathing your Baby

Wipe your baby clean with a cloth until the cord falls off.

It is recommended to bathe the baby every day or every other day after the cord falls off.

Bath water temperature should be 37-38 degrees.

Feed your baby only breast milk for the first six months and continue breastfeeding until the age of two and beyond.

If you observe at least one of the following symptoms in your baby, CONTACT THE NEAREST HEALTHCARE FACILITY.

Blue lips Not latching Jaundice Excessive and frequent vomiting Three or more watery stools per day Rapid breathing or periodic breathing Skin pulling in between the ribs or under the ribcage with each breath Redness, itching, discharge, bleeding, and swelling in the navel Spasms in the arms and legs High fever or cooling of the skin



Healthy babies should also be checked regularly
